HISTON FEAST

With the generous support of the residents of Histon and Impington we are able to raise and subsequently distribute a significant sum of money annually to those local Charities, Groups and Organisations who have requested funding.

We are always keen to support new Charities, Groups and Organisations as well as maintaining a level of support to those who have benefited in the past.

The Histon Feast Committee has agreed some general guidelines for applicants and nominees:

- There should be benefit to the local communities from every donation given. This does not mean that donations only go to local Charities, Groups and Organisations. It does mean however that a donation should be put to a purpose that could benefit the local communities. Examples of Charities, Groups and Organisations that have been given support in recent years, but fall into this wider group are: Arthur Rank House and MAGPAS.
- Support for a specific purpose / project is preferred, rather than providing support to general funds. Examples in 2004 of support for specific purposes / projects were high back chairs for the Histon & Impington Day Centre and on-going funding for a Mobile Warden Scheme for the elderly.
- Charities, Groups and Organisations are not normally supported if they have received funding within three years of a current application.
- The Histon Feast Committee has currently agreed 4 exceptions to the "two year rule".
- The Council of Churches Holiday Club, The Histon Feast Community Minibus, the Histon Branch of the Red Cross and the Histon & Impington Mobile warden scheme all currently receive annual support.

Please note the Histon Feast Committee expect each applicant Charity, Group and Organisation to help sell Histon Feast programmes.

Histon Feast Funding Cycle

Applications to be made during November, December and early January.

Histon Feast AGM held in late January. At which we ask that a representative from each applicant briefly explain what they require funding for.

Histon Feast Committee meet after the AGM to decide which applications to support in principle.

Histon Feast takes place late June / early July.

Histon Feast Committee meet late summer to agree / confirm what funds they are able to give out.

Charities, Groups and Organisations advised late summer.

Donations made at a formal presentations evening in October.
